Event Rules

The EA Rules for Jumping, FEI Rules for Jumping and/or all relevant FEI Rule Books for any eventuality not covered. In any unforeseen or exceptional circumstances, it is the Event Organisers responsibility to decide in a sporting spirit and in accordance with the intention of these rules.

Entering this event constitutes knowledge and acceptance of these rules, and a completed entry acknowledges understanding and acceptance of all Conditions of Entry.

Riders Eligibility to Compete

The event is open to all Albany Equestrian Centre members, ie. Members of A.H.A., A.P.C., A.N.T.S., A.A.R.C., S.D.D.C. & Friends of the A.E.C.

Non-Members (eg KRPC) are also able to take part on payment of the casual member fee which provides for membership of the A.E.C. for this event.

Classes. Horses are restricted to 4 classes on the day.

Riders may nominate on the day which heights they wish to jump in each class.

The 30cm and lead rein classes will be held as the first classes of the day.

Prizes. Ribbons will be awarded to third place.

Number of Entries Permitted per Rider

There is no restriction on the number of entries permitted per rider.

(Riders may ride one height only)

Class 13 – 45cm

(Riders may ride one height only)

Class 17 – 45cm-65cm

Class 18 – 80cm-95cm

Class 19 – 100cm-105cm

No entries accepted without payment of appropriate fees.

2. Entries **close: 9 February 2022**. Late entries may be accepted on payment of an additional fee of \$10 per horse/rider combination.
3. The helper duties will be available on www.albanyequestrian.net/comingevents.htm from: **10 February 2022**.
4. **Dress.** Helmets must be of approved standard and worn at all times while mounted.
5. **Emergency Contact Person.** When completing your entry, please enter the name and phone number of the Emergency Contact Person who will be with you at the event.
6. **Helpers.** All competitors must nominate a helper capable of completing the allotted helper duty, or pay a \$25.00 helper fee. Please be prompt for your helper duty.
Riders may self-help for one horse only. If riding more than 1 horse, an additional helper will need to be provided or an additional \$25 will be payable. Special Requests will be filled only if the duty is available, or else another helper duty will be allocated.

The maximum number of helpers required for any particular helper duty are set out on the entry form, and these will be filled as entries are received. Any rider stipulating one of these duties after the maximum number has been reached, will be allocated another helper duty at the discretion of the Event Organiser. Where the helper is nominated for more than one horse taking part in the competition, that helper may be allocated a second helper duty.

Everyone is responsible for taking the arenas down, and presentations will take place when they are all packed away.

7. **Refreshments.** A barbecue sausage sizzle, drinks and cakes will be available..
8. **Code of Conduct.** Please ensure you are familiar with the A.E.C. Code of Conduct

9. **Protests & Appeals.** Must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$50, within 20 minutes of the results being Announced.
10. **Officials & Volunteers.** These people are essential in the running of our competitions and events. Please treat them with respect.

Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. Verbal or physical bullying behaviour may result in disciplinary action being taken where appropriate.

11. **Duty of Care.** It is your responsibility to report unsafe and/or hazardous situations to the Organising Committee.
12. **A.E.C. Stallion Code of Conduct** will apply. Refer www.albanyequestrian.net/aec-constitution-policies
13. **Yards & Camping.** There are yards and camping available at the Centre, however, no powered sites. If yards are used, they must be cleaned of manure and hay before leaving. There is no additional cost for use of the yards, but the cost of camping is \$5/competitor per night and must be included on your entry form.
14. **Withdrawals & Refunds.** Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 3 days of the completion of the event (**16 February**), and in such cases, there will be a full refund less an administration fee of \$10.
15. **Dogs.** Dogs must always be kept on a leash.
16. **Disclaimer of Liability.** Neither the Organising Committee, E.A. nor the Albany Equestrian Centre accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. By submitting an entry form for this event, all riders accept the Dangerous Activity Acknowledgement. The Albany Equestrian Centre accepts no liability for the loss of, or damage to, vehicles, or any other goods or articles, and does not offer any personal insurance to riders.
17. **Reservation of Right:** The Organising Committee reserves the right:
 - a. To cancel any class or event.
 - b. To divide any class.
 - c. To transfer competitors between sections of a class.
 - d. To alter the advertised times; and
 - e. To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason.
